SELF-PACED



Online classes can hold some advantages over in-person classes and many of you have responded positively to our online offerings. We know that even when the pandemic has receded and we are able to resume in-person classes, there will continue to be demand for online classes.

Identifying the Types of Online Classes In This Catalog

- **Live Online Classes** : These are classes where an online meeting is being used like an in-person classroom. Days and times for the meetings are specified, with online lectures being used as the primary way in which course content is being presented. These classes will either utilize Webex or Blackboard (with Blackboard Collaborate Ultra for class meetings). Information on your virtual classroom will come directly from your instructor via email.
- **Self-Paced Online Classes** : In these classes, content (lectures, readings, videos, etc.) is placed on a protected website (Blackboard, in most instances) Some self-paced classes may have occasional class meetings, though meetings are not the primary way in which content is being presented to you. Self-paced classes will have active instructor participation even without live meetings. You will receive instructions for accessing the class materials prior to the start of classes via email.

How do I know which is which?

Our classes are labeled as “Live Online” and “Self-Paced Online”, so that you know how each class will be conducted. When you register for a class, your instructor will send an email to you 1 -2 days before the start of the class with information about how the class will be taught and applicable login information.

We hope that the information we are providing to you in our catalog and online will help you to make your enrollment decisions. We know our print catalog is convenient but as always, the most complete and current information is online at ce.harpercollege.edu.

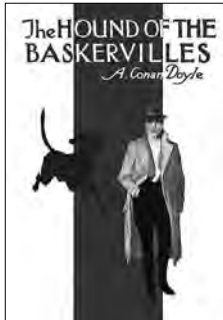

Electrical Hazard Awareness and Lockout/Tagout



On average, three workers die weekly from exposure to electricity and almost half of the workers injured by electricity are away from work for more than two weeks. Reducing accidental exposure to electricity can increase job safety and decrease lost production time. Workers can protect themselves by understanding sources of electric shock, recognizing potential hazards and knowing how to mitigate or avoid electrical hazards. Lockout/Tagout is used to prevent injuries during service or maintenance of equipment from all sources of energy, including electricity. Upon course completion, you will have a better understanding and the working knowledge necessary to recognize electrical hazards.

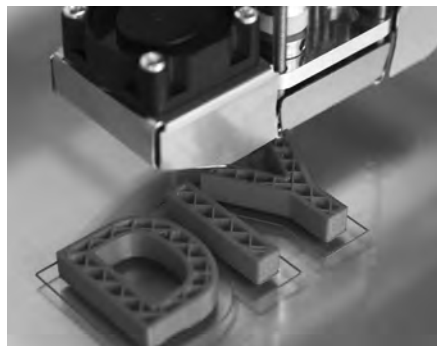

When the U.S. Highway system was created on November 11, 1926, over 96,000 miles of roads under the jurisdiction of the 48 states were given uniform numbers to assist the motoring public. Route 66 was unique on the map, tracing a crescent-shaped path 2448 miles from Chicago to Los Angeles through 8 states. Within Illinois, 66 would connect Chicago to East St. Louis by way of Bloomington and Springfield. This diagonal path was one of the oldest travel corridors in the state. Then came the railroads and farm-to-market paths along section lines. 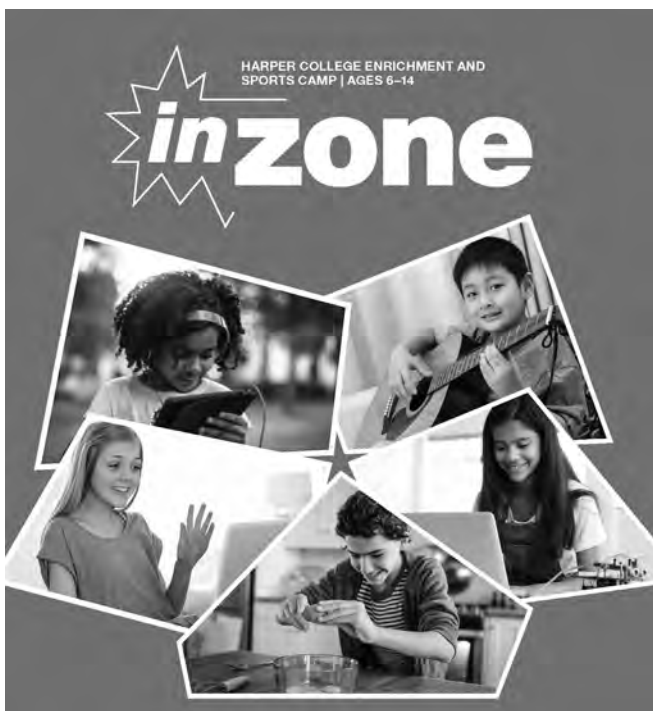

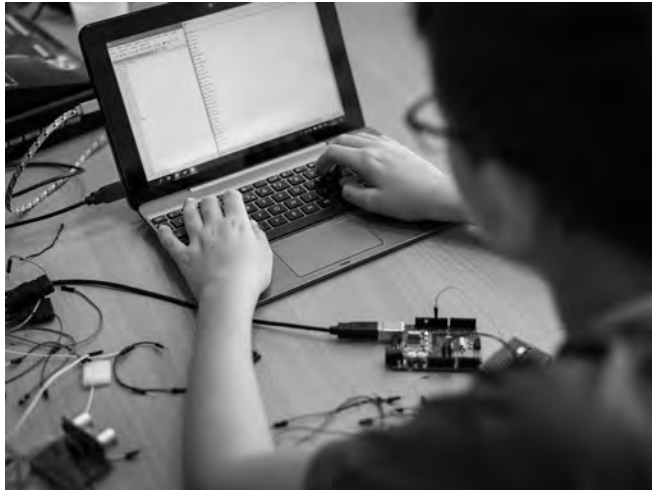

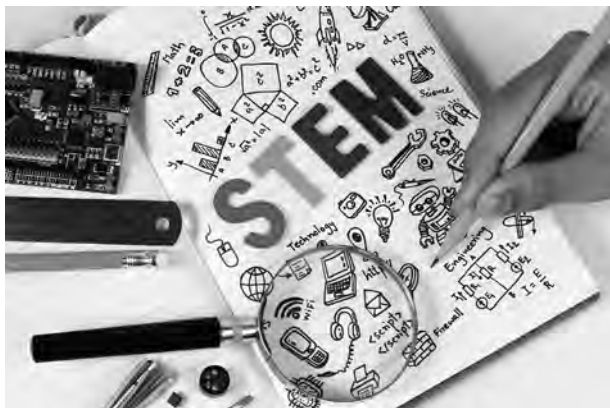

Types of Online Classes InZone will be providing in 2021:

- **Live Online Classes** : These are classes where an online meeting is being used like an in-person classroom. Days and times for the meetings are specified, with online lectures being used as the primary way in which course content is being presented. These classes will either utilize Webex or Blackboard (with Blackboard Collaborate Ultra for class meetings).
- **Self-Paced Online Classes** : In these classes, content (lectures, readings, videos, etc.) is placed on a protected website (Blackboard, in most instances) Some self-paced classes may have occasional class meetings, though meetings are not the primary way in which content is being presented to you. Self-paced classes will have active instructor participation even without live meetings.

Our personalized approach means you have choices. You choose the dates and class times that fit your schedule.
