



#### Drop-off/Pick-Up Times

### Late Pick-Up Procedure and Offenses

### Ages

Students must be **eight years old before September 1, 2026 in order to participate in InZone programs for students 8-14 years old.** The InZone curriculum is designed to be age-appropriate. It is the responsibility of a parent or guardian to ensure that his or her child is placed in an age-appropriate class. Select courses are open to students younger or older than InZone's standard 8-14 range. **Children must turn six years old by September 1, 2026 in order to participate in the InZone Junior Explorers Camps for students 6-8 years old.**

# Program Details

## Class Capacity and Cancellations

In keeping with our mission to provide individualized instruction, InZone enrollment is limited to maintain our **8:1 ratio of kids to adults**. As a non-profit organization whose programs are self-supporting, InZone also requires a minimum number of enrolled students in order to run a class. To avoid inconvenience to students, InZone staff will cancel a course with low enrollment one full week in advance of the start date and offer students alternate classes, or a full refund. Avoid disappointment and register early!
