Items to bring or prepare for the first class:

- Oblique Pen Holder - Moblique 2-In-1 Pen Holder (recommended) or any oblique pen holder with brass flange (not Speedball Oblique Holder)
- Nibs - Speedball Hunt 101 Nibs (2-3)
- Ink - Tom Norton Walnut Drawing Ink, Daniel Smith Walnut Ink, or Walnut Ink Crystals
- Paper - Canson Pro Layout Marker Pad 9x12, Canson XL Marker Pad 9x12, Rhodia pad, or any smooth paper you can see guidelines through
- Water jar
- A few paper towels
- Pencil & paper for taking notes, if desired
- Dinky Dips (which are small vials for ink)
- Dinky Dips with Screw-top Caps / Item #dinkydsc, square base (recommended) or rectangular base / Item #S934-Rectangle or Jumbo Dinky Dip, 1 Jar Square / item #S853-1-Square
